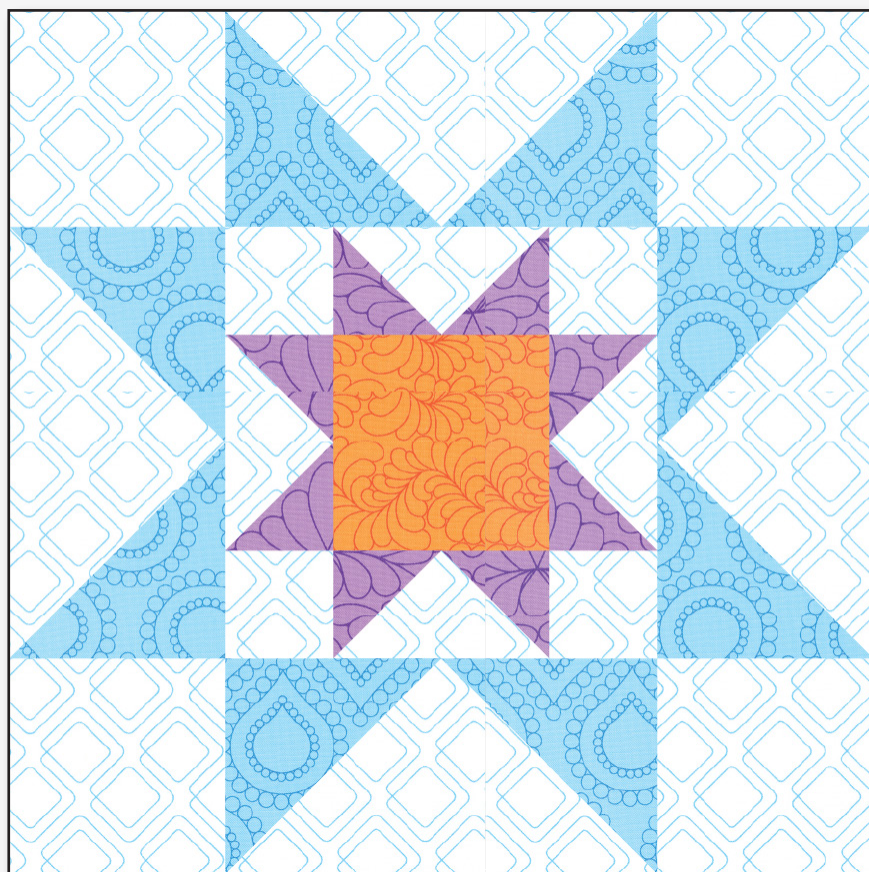


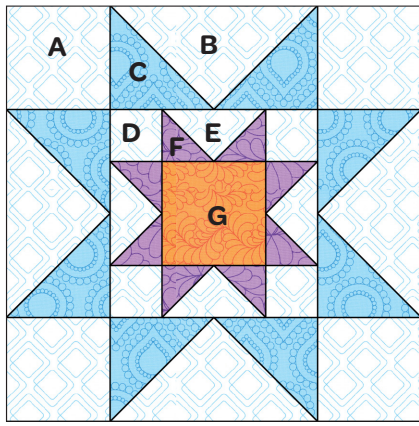
Double Sawtooth Star Block

Cutting Instructions

Flying Geese -Four at a Time:

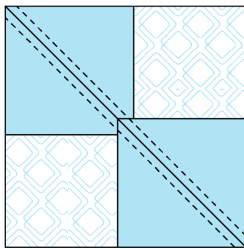
- (B) - (1) $7\frac{1}{2}$ " sq; or $7\frac{3}{4}$ " extra for trimming down
- (C) - (4) 4"; or $4\frac{1}{4}$ " extra for trimming down
- (E) - (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ "; or $4\frac{3}{4}$ " extra for trimming down
- (F) - (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ "; or $2\frac{3}{4}$ " extra for trimming down

Squares & Triangles:

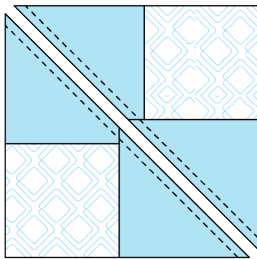
- (G) - (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " sq
- (G) - (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " sq
- (D) - (4) 2" sq

Four at a time Flying Geese Block

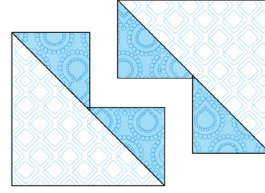
1. Place a (C) square with right sides together on the (B) square in the opposite diagonal corners.
2. Draw a line diagonally according to diagram.
3. Stitch a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the line.



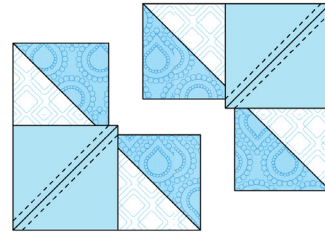
4. Cut apart on the line between the stitching.



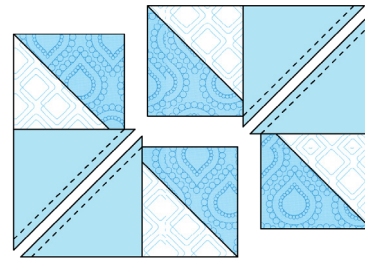
5. Press seams towards the smaller triangles.



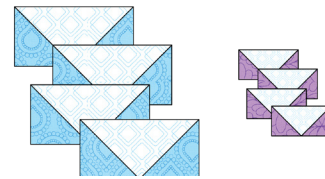
6. Place the remaining (C) squares in the corner of the large triangles right sides together.
7. Draw a line diagonally on the back of the (C) squares according to diagram.



8. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the line on both sides of the line.
9. Cut apart on the line.



10. Press seam towards the smaller triangle.
11. Trim flying geese to $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "



Small Star Tooth Star Block:

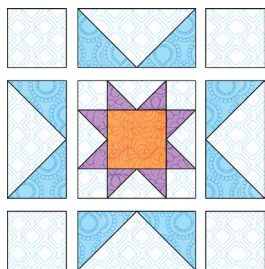
1. Follow instructions for eight at a time flying geese using (F, E) pieces.
2. Trim to 2 " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "
3. Assembly in same way as the assembly diagram for the larger block.
4. Trim to $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Quilt Examples

1. Arrange block according to diagram.



2. Sew blocks together for each row.
3. Sew the rows together matching seams.
4. Press block.
