

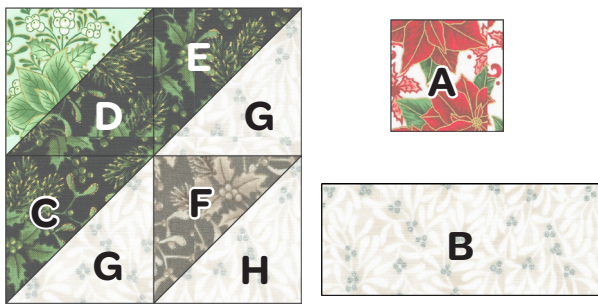
Christmas Tree Block

Cutting Instructions

Background Fabric 1/2 Yard

B - (4) 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" sq

G - (1) 4 3/4" x WOF strip - (2) If using FQ 4 3/4" x 22" strips

H - (2) 6 1/4" sq

Red Fabric Scrap

A - (1) 4 1/2"

Dark Green Fabric 1 Fat Quarter

D - (2) 6 1/4" sq

E - (1) 4 3/4" x WOF strip - (2) If using FQ 4 3/4" x 22" strips

Light Green Fabric 1 Fat Quarter

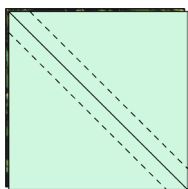
C - (2) 6 1/4" sq

Brown Fabric 1 Fat Quarter

F - (2) 6 1/4" sq

Two at a time HST

1. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on all the (C) squares.
2. Layer (C) squares with an (D) square right sides together.
3. Sew a 1/4" away from the drawn line on both sides of the line.
4. Cut apart on the line between the stitching.

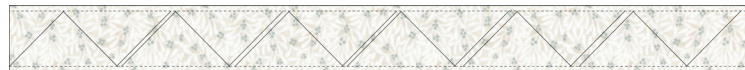

5. Press seams towards the darker triangles.
6. Trim to 5 1/2" square.
7. Repeat for (F) and (H) squares.

Strip Tube HST

1. Sew an (E) and (G) strip with right sides together on both sides of the length of the strip.
2. Use the strip tube ruler; line up the 5 1/2" line along one side of the tube.
3. Cut the tube into a triangle with the tip of the ruler. 8 times.
4. Rotate the tube and cut a triangle from the other side.
5. Press seams open.



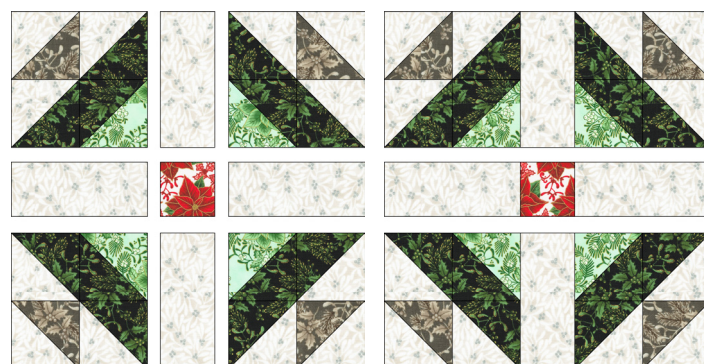
8 Total HST

Block Assembly

1. Sew the corner units together referring to the diagram below.
2. Repeat for all 4 units.

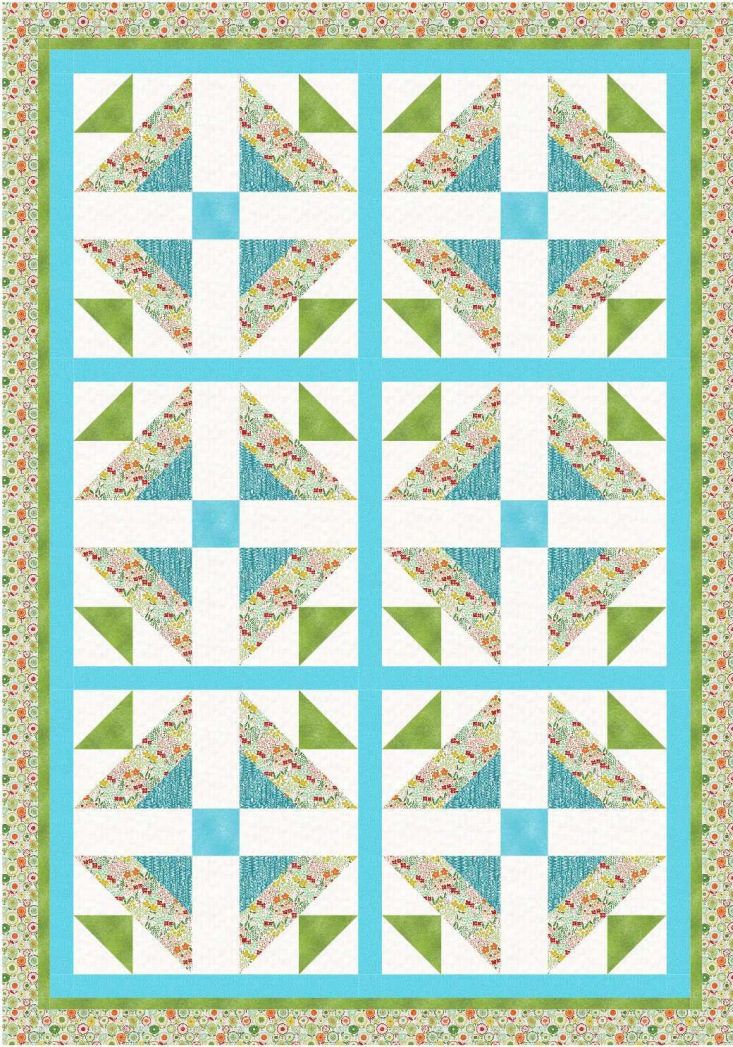


1. Arrange units, rectangles and square according to diagram below.
2. Sew the units in the row together.
3. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Christmas Tree Block

Quilt with 2" sashing and 3" borders.



Quilt with no sashing and 3" borders.
