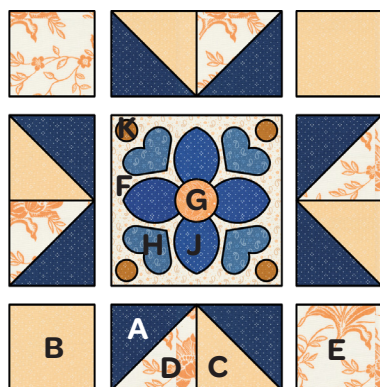
22" x 36" Table Runner Pattern



Yardage

- ½ yard background fabric
- 1 ¼ yard dark blue for star/ backing/binding
- 1 fat quarter brown
- 1 fat quarter medium orange print
- 1 fat quarter light orange print
- 1 fat quarter light orange solid
- 1 fat quarter medium blue print 1
- 1 fat quarter medium blue print 2

Star Block



Cutting

Background

- (1) 6½" square, center star (F)

Dark Blue

- (2) 6½" squares, star points HST (A)

Light Orange

- (1) 6½" squares, star points HST (C)
- (2) 3½" squares (B)

Light Orange Print

- (1) 6½" squares, star points HST (D)
- (2) 3½" squares (E)

*For the following applique, apply steam a seam 2 to the back of fabric before cutting out with templates. SVGs have also been provided.

Dark Orange Print

- (1) 2" square, flower center (G) from template

Medium Blue Print 1

- (1) 2" square, (4) flower petals (J) from template

Medium Blue Print 2

- (1) 5" square, (4) flower hearts (H) from template

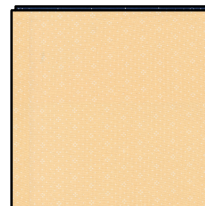
Brown Print

- (1) 3" square, (4) flower hearts (K) from template

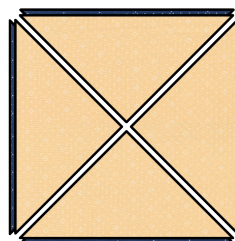
Sewing

4 at a Time HST

1. Layer the 6½" (A, D) and (A,C) squares right sides together.



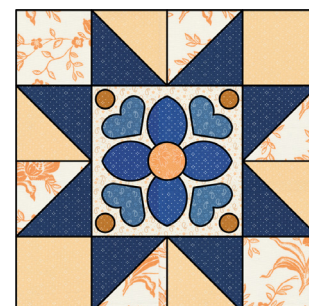
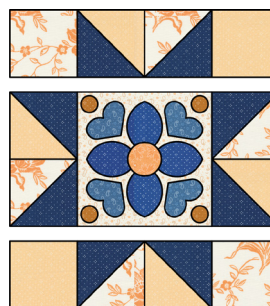
2. Sew a ¼" from the edge of the square all the way around.
3. Cut apart on the diagonal in both directions.



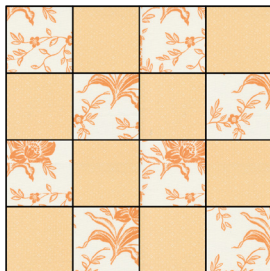
4. Trim to 3 ½" HST.

Block Assembly

1. Use a light box or window to apply the applique to the center square. Use the diagram to place in the right position.
2. Use a blanket stitch or zig zag to tack down the applique.
3. Arrange the block according to the diagram.
4. Sew each row together.
5. Sew the sewn rows together to complete the block.

Light Orange

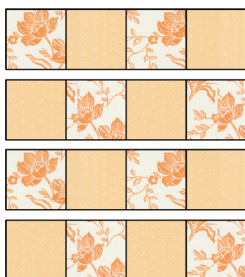
- (2) 3½" x WOF;

Light Orange Print

- (2) 3½" x WOF;

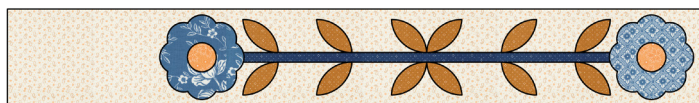
Sewing

1. Sew the strips right sides together on the long edge. Using 1 strip from each color.
2. Iron towards the darker fabric.
3. Cut the strips into (16) 3 ½" wide sections.
4. Arrange units into rows for 2 blocks.
5. Sew rows together.



6. Sew the sewn rows together to finish blocks.

Flower Applique



Cutting

Background

- (2) 5½" x 36 ½";

Dark Blue Print

- (2) 1½" x 21", stem

Medium Blue Prints

- (2) 5" x 10" from each print; cut (4) from the flower template

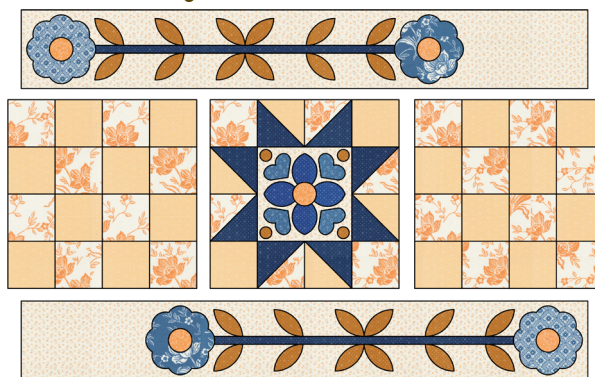
Medium Blue Prints

- (1) 8" x 12" from each print; cut (4) from the leaf template

Applique

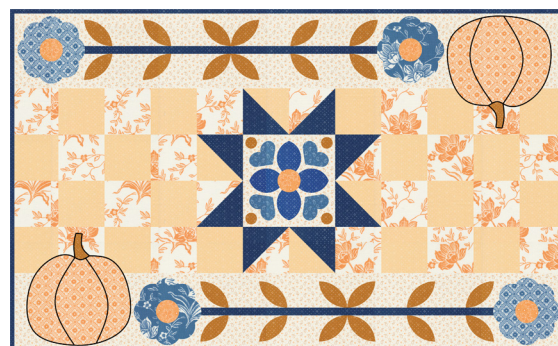
1. Print 2 copies of the applique diagram.
2. Tape the flower applique diagram together on the red lines.
3. Using a light box or laying the background fabric over the template, arrange the applique matching the diagram.
4. Iron on and use a blanket stitch or zig zag to secure the applique.

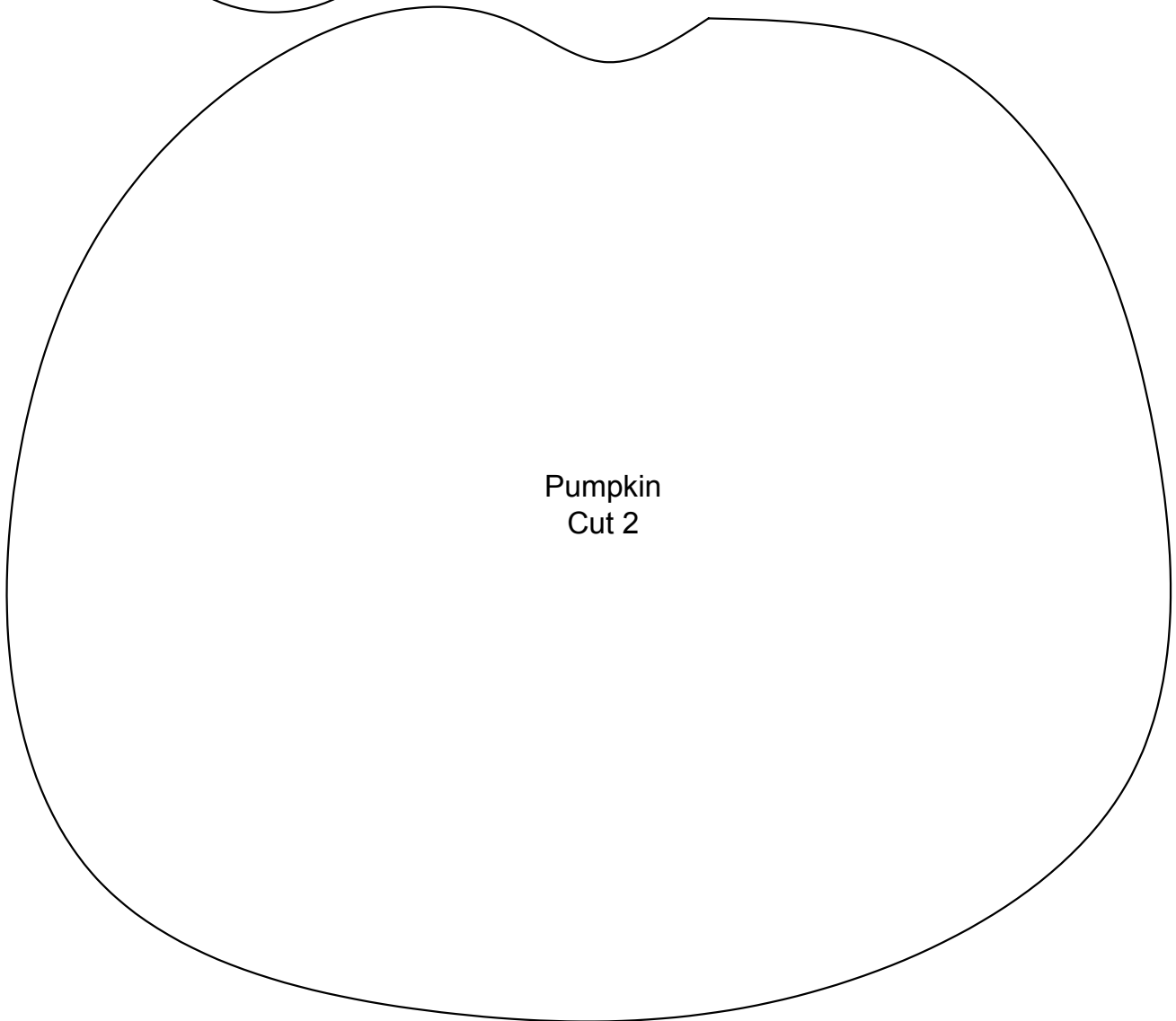
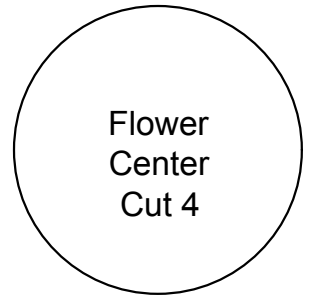
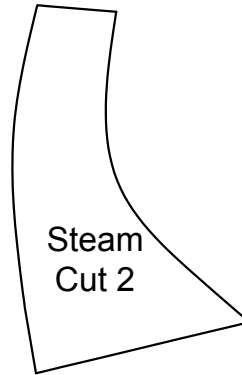
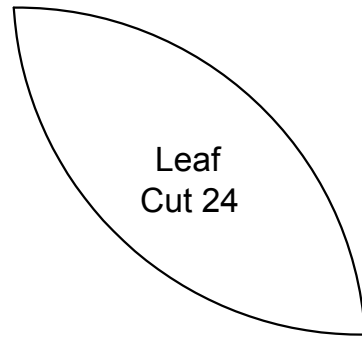
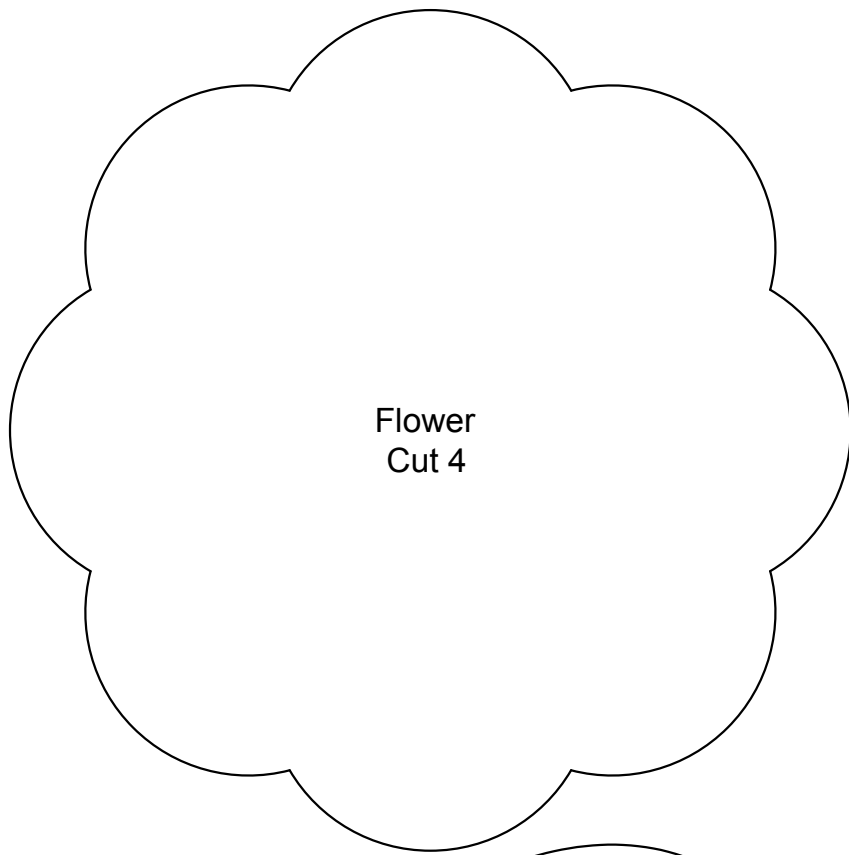
Quilt Assembly

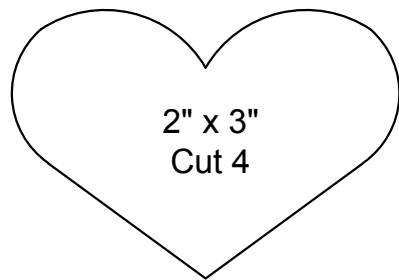


Quilt Assembly

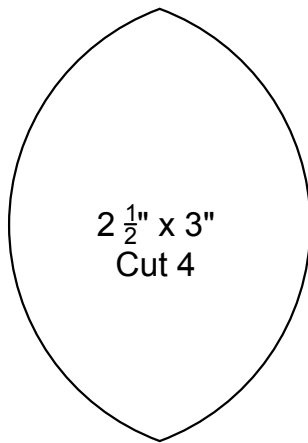
1. Sew the blocks together, then the flower applique top and bottom rows.
2. Cut the pumpkin and stem applique out from the templates.
3. Apply the pumpkin in the empty space next to the flower applique and overlapping the 12 patch blocks.
4. Iron on and secure applique with a blanket or zig zag stitch.



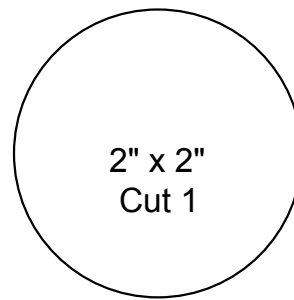




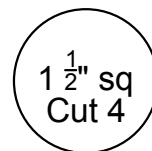

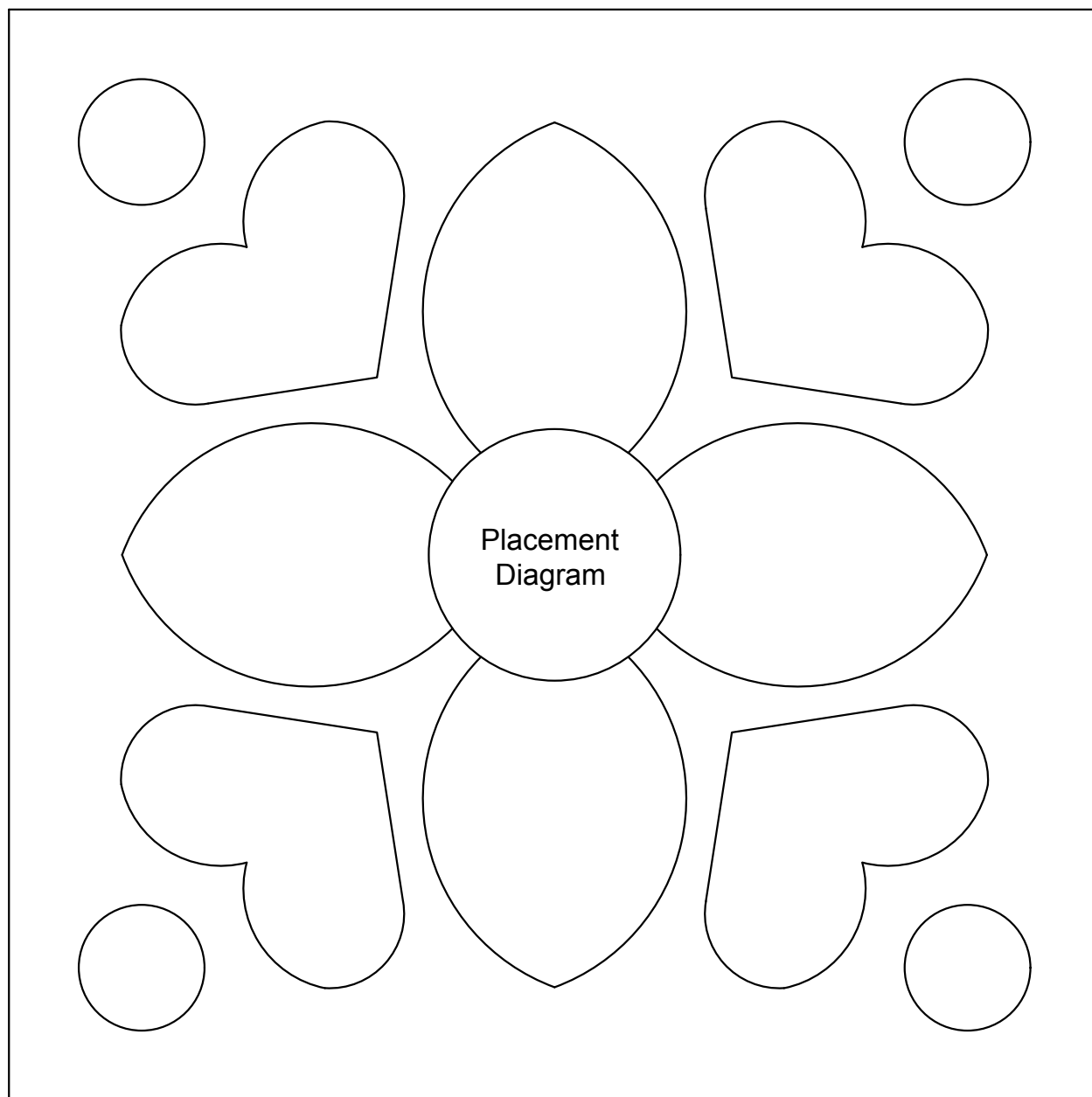
