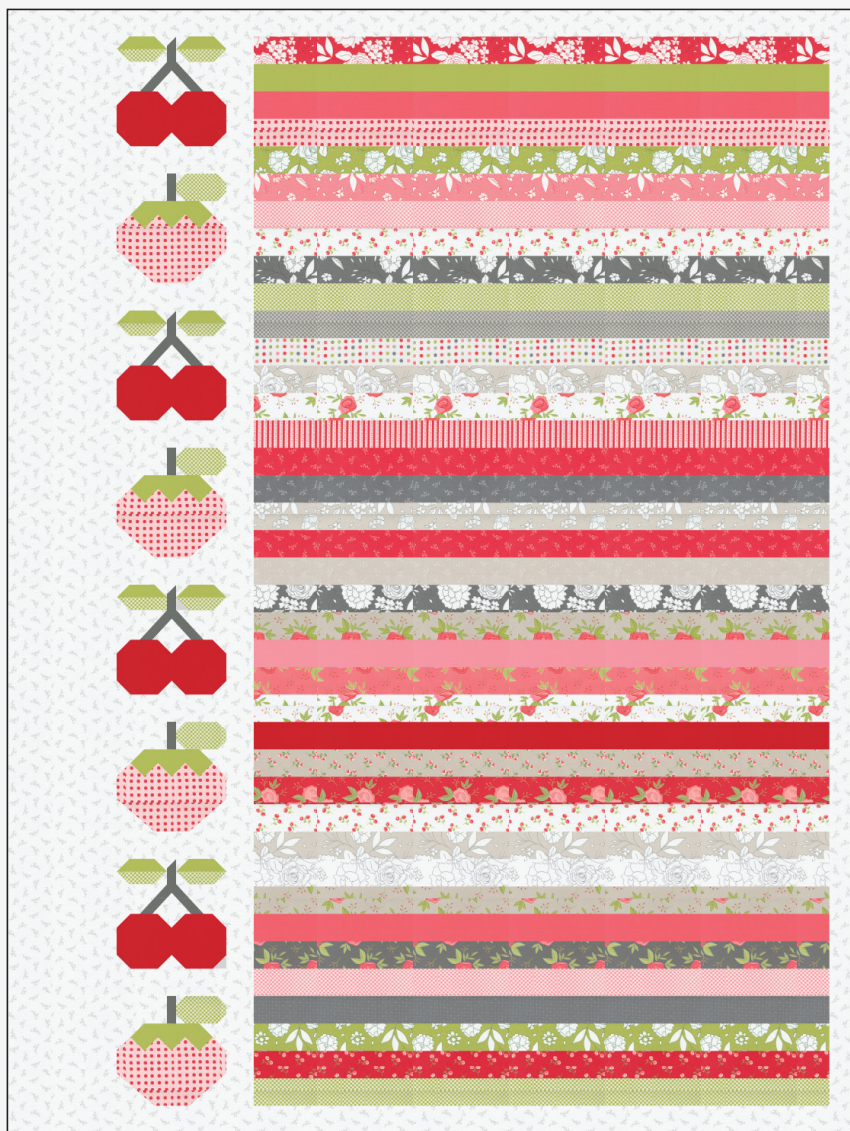

62" x 82" Quilt Pattern



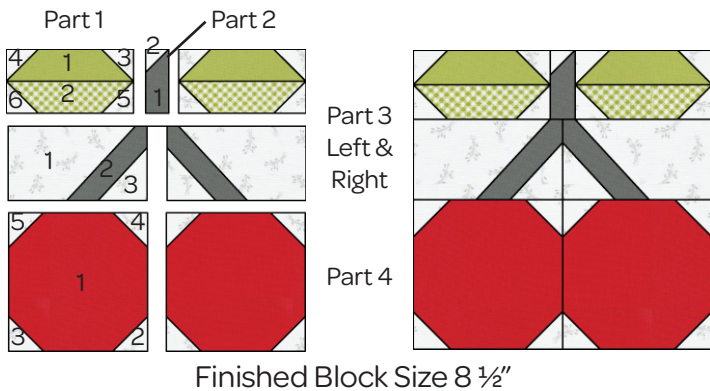
Cherry Berry Quilt

Yardage

- (1) Jelly roll
- 2 yards background fabric
- 1 Fat quarter - med green
- 1 Fat eighth - brown
- 1 Fat quarter - red
- 1 Fat quarter - pink
- 1 Fat eighth - light green
- ½ yard binding

HST = half square triangle, QST = quarter-square

FPB Blocks



Cherry Block - Part 1 - Leaves

Sec	Qty	Cut Size
1	8	2" x 4½"
2	8	2" x 4½"
3, 4, 5, 6	16	3"sq, Cut into (32) HST ☐

Cherry Block - Part 2 - Stem

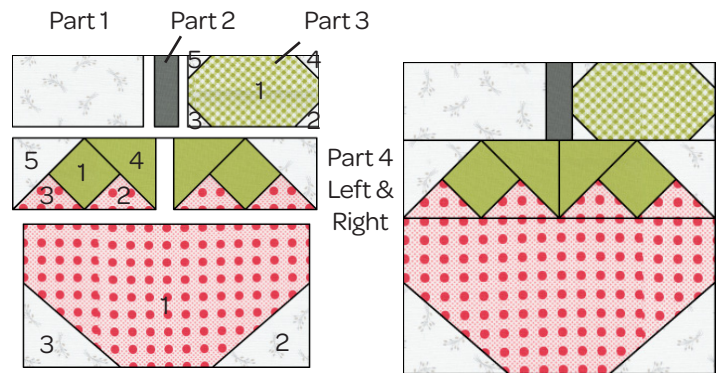
Sec	Qty	Cut Size
1	4	2" x 3"
2	2	3"sq, Cut into (4) HST ☐

Cherry Block - Part 3 - Stems to Cherry

Sec	Qty	Cut Size
1	4	4" x 5"
2	4	2" x 5"
3	4	4"sq, Cut into (8) HST ☐

Cherry Block - Part 4 - Cherry

Sec	Qty	Cut Size
1	8	5" sq
2,3,4,5	16	3"sq, Cut into (32) HST ☐



Strawberry Block - Part 1-3 - Stem, Leaves

Sec	Qty	Cut Size
Part 1	4	2" x 4½"
Part 2	4	2½" x 1⅛"
Part 3		
1	4	3" x 4½"
2,3,4,5	8	4" sq. Cut into (16) HST ☐

Strawberry Block - Part 4 - Top

Sec	Qty	Cut Size
1	8	2½" sq
2 & 3	4	4" sq, Cut into (16) QST ☒
4	4	4" sq, Cut into (8) HST ☐
5	4	4" sq. Cut into (8) HST ☐

Strawberry Block - Part 5 - Strawberry

Sec	Qty	Cut Size
1	8	2½" sq
2 & 3	4	4" sq, Cut into (16) QST ☒

Borders and Sashing

- (9) 2 ½" x WOF; Sub cut the following;
 - (7) 2 ½" x 8 ½" (Block sashing)
- Sew remaining strips end to end and cut after piecing blocks and body. Measure first;
 - (2) 2 ½" x 78 ½" (Border between blocks and Jelly Roll strips & right side border)
 - (2) 2 ½" x 60 ½" (Top / bottom border)
- (2) 8 ½" x WOF; Sew end to end; Sub cut;
 - (1) 8 ½" x 78 ½" (Side border)

Foundation Paper Piece (FPP) Instructions

Note: Print foundation templates at 100% / actual size.

1. Print 4 copies of the foundation patterns for each cherry and strawberry block.
2. Decide on your fabric colors and label each section on the pattern according to your fabric choice.
3. Cut fabric according to cutting chart and layout on your table space in the order you will sew the fabric to the foundation papers.
4. Sew the foundation papers starting with section 1. Use the glue stick to glue the wrong side of the fabric to the paper on the back side covering the seam allowance around section 1.
5. Fold back the paper using a piece of cardboard or thin plastic along the line between section 1 and 2.
6. Trim the fabric by laying the Add-A-Quarter ruler along the folded paper and trimming.
7. Lay your section 2 fabric under the section 1 fabric with right sides together along the seam allowance you trimmed in the previous step.
8. Fold the paper flat and sew on the bold line between section 1 and 2.
9. Press the sewn section open.
10. Continue with the next section by repeating step 5 through 10.
11. After the paper pattern is complete, iron flat and trim on the outside line. Leave the paper on.

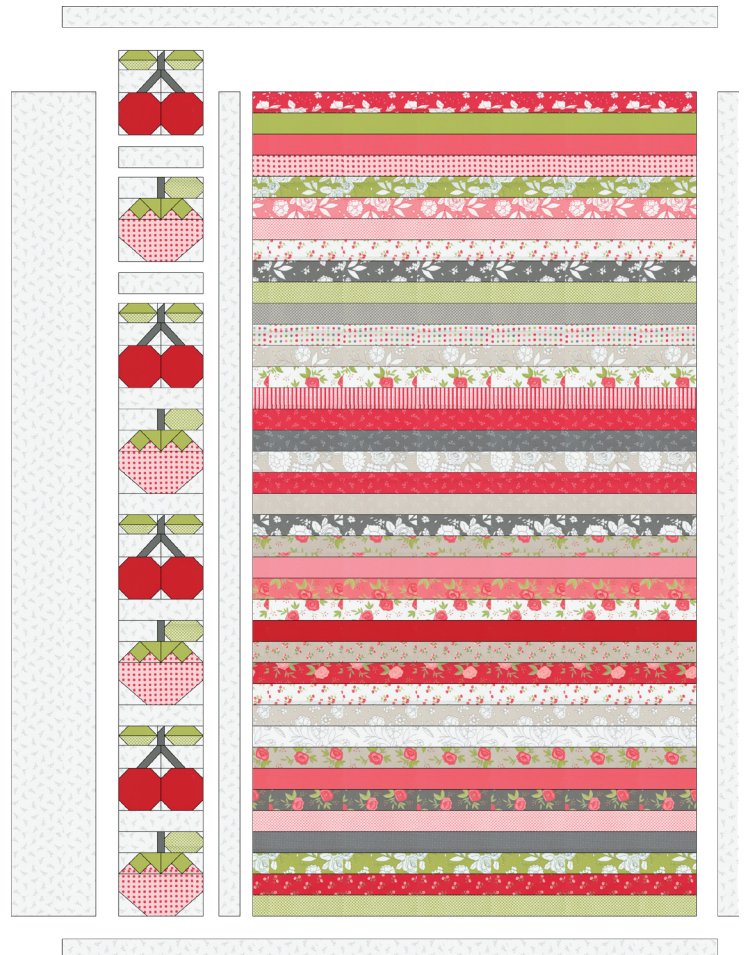
Block Piecing

1. Arrange the unit pieces after paper piecing, according to the diagrams.
2. Sew units together and press blocks.

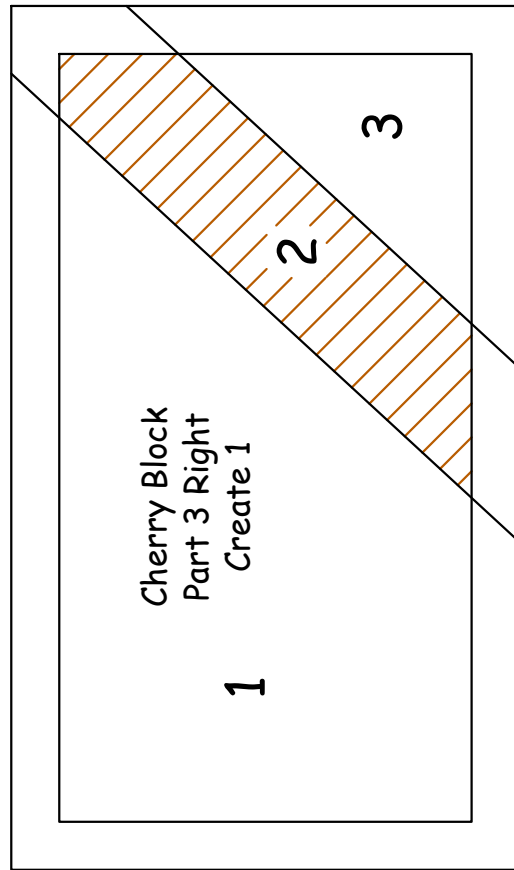
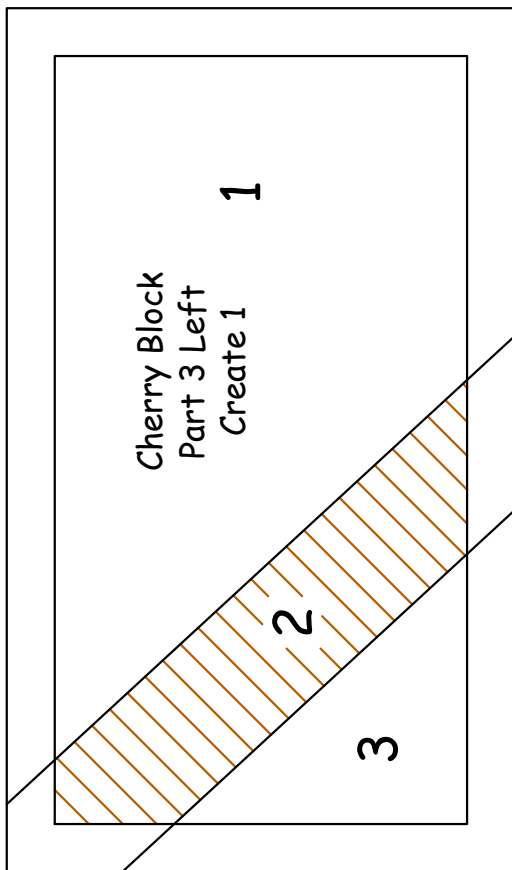
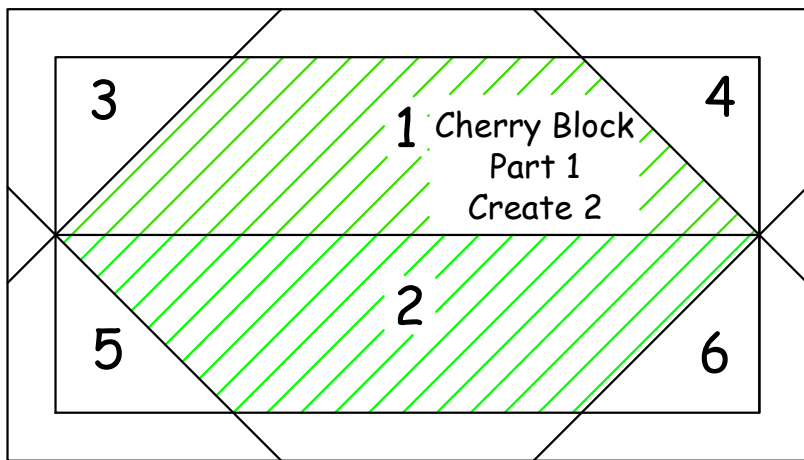
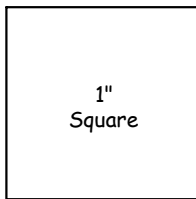
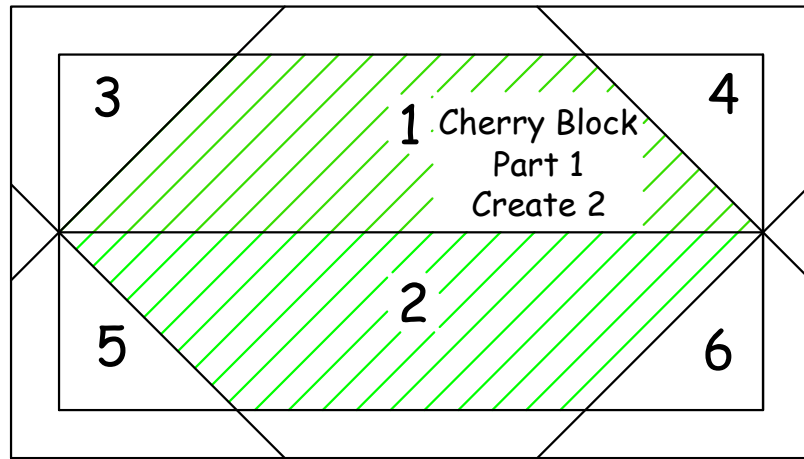
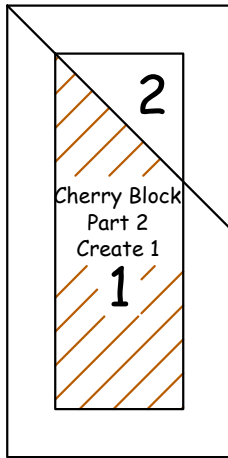
Sewing

1. Make 4 Cherry Blocks.
2. Make 4 Strawberry Blocks.
3. Sew block sashings between blocks to create the left column. Add the 8 ½" border to the left side of the block column.
4. Add the 2 ½" border to the right side of the block column.
5. Choose (39) Jelly Row strips. Trim salvage off the ends.
6. Find shortest Jelly Row strip and trim all to that length. The pattern assumes it is (42 ½"). Adjust border lengths if it is smaller.

7. Sew all Jelly Roll strips together to create the center panel. Press in the same direction.
8. Sew center panel to block section.
9. Add remaining side border.
10. Sew top and bottom border on.

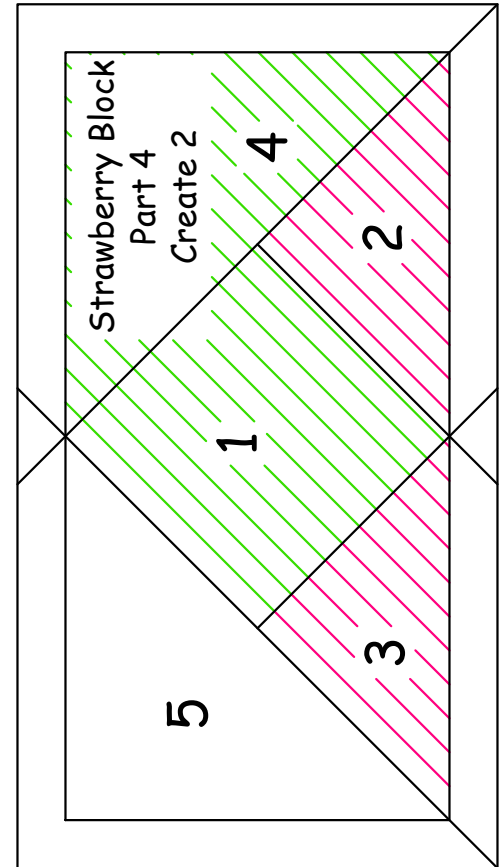
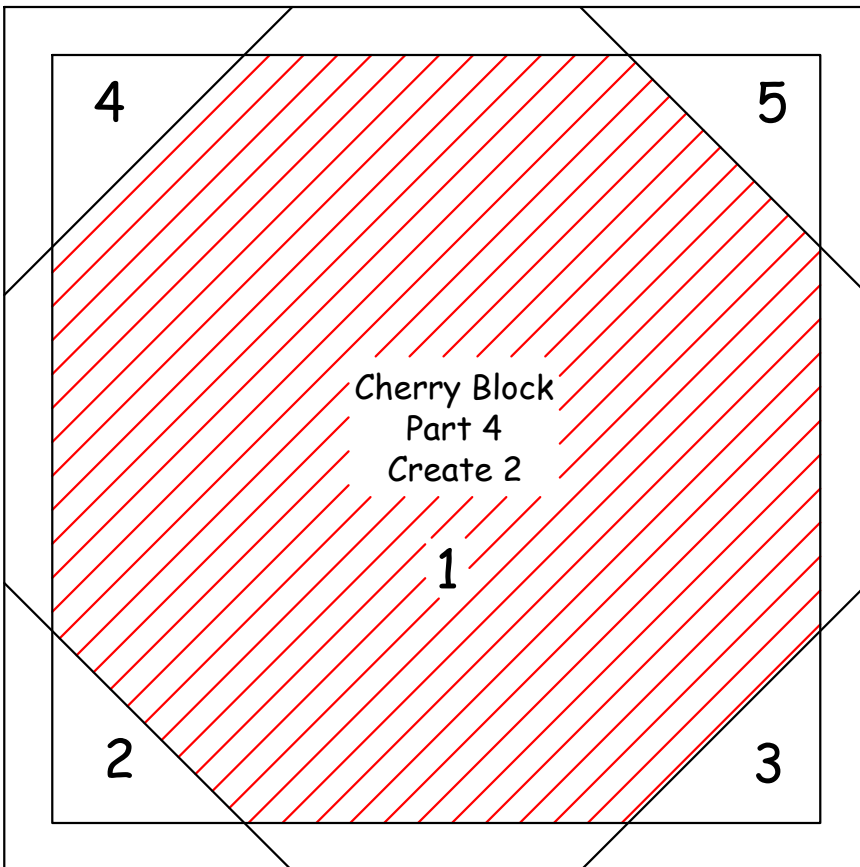
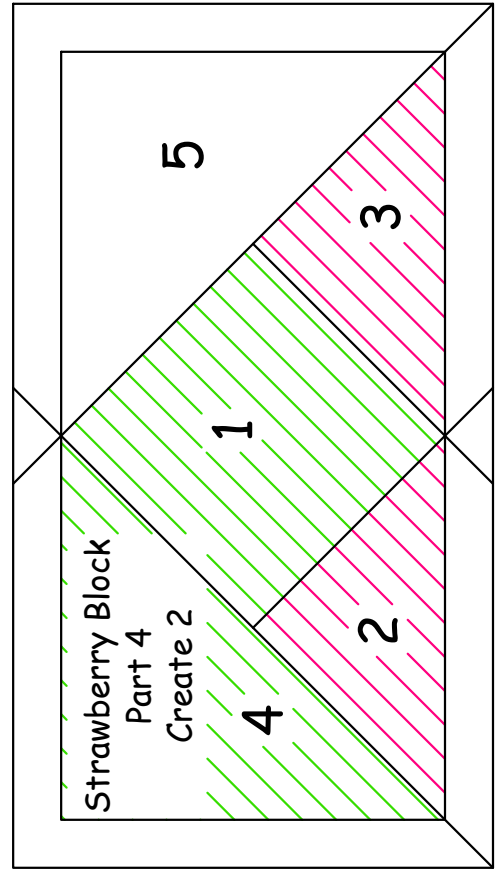
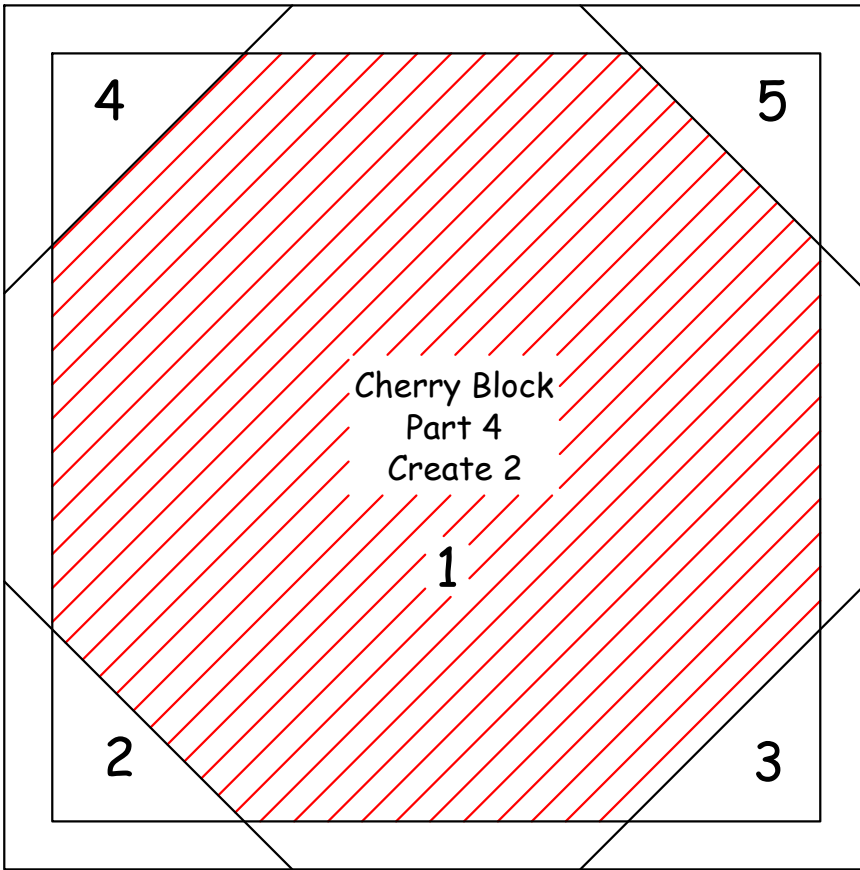


FPP Pattern - Page 1
